## GEO 7X HANDHELD: VERIZON™ NETWORK ACTIVATION

## **SUMMARY**

By default, the Trimble Geo 7X handheld's integrated modem is set to connect to GSM/UMTS networks with a SIM card. The handheld is also certified for use with the US cellular network operator Verizon operating in CDMA/EV-DO mode. The handheld can not be used on other CDMA/EV-DO networks.


To use the Geo 7X handheld on the Verizon network, you must:

- have an account with Verizon.
- register the handheld with Verizon to enable it to connect to the network.

## **PROCEDURE**

To register the handheld with Verizon:

- Provide the handheld's MEID (unique cell radio identifier) to your Verizon account contact. To find the MEID for your Geo 7X handheld, do one of the following:
  - look on the MEDI/IMEI label on the back of the handheld (the MEID is the first 14 digits)
  - make sure the phone is turned on (in the Geo 7 Series User Guide, see Using the Wireless Manager for more information), then tap Start / Settings / System / System Information / Modem.
- 2. Once the handheld has been registered on the Verizon network (this can take a couple of days, check with your Verizon contact), enable and activate CDMA on the handheld.

To enable CDMA operation on the handheld:

**Important:** The activation step requires that the handheld be able to connect to the Verizon network during the activation sequence. Check your location's Verizon network coverage using the Verizon Coverage Locator: <a href="http://www.verizonwireless.com/b2c/support/coverage-locator">http://www.verizonwireless.com/b2c/support/coverage-locator</a>

- 1. Tap Start / Settings / Personal / Cellular Network.
- 2. From the *Network Type* dropdown list, select CDMA, then tap **OK**. The modem resets and reinitializes in CDMA mode.
- 3. To activate CDMA, make the phone is turned on, and connected to the Verizon network in an area of good coverage (the signal-strength indicator should show at least two bars). Tap Start / Settings / Personal / Cellular Network and then click Activate.

A pop-up message indicates that activation was successful. This may take several minutes.
